



Survey on “Plastic convertor’s barriers for using plastic recyclates”

The CREATOR research project...

...is a European collaboration that aims to recycle complex waste streams that contain hazardous (legacy) flame retardants, i.e. HBCD and PBDE. The partners aim to create an economically viable business model, taking into account the entire value chain, from collecting the waste, recycling it with advanced purification methods, to deploying the recyclates into new products.

Before bringing our high-quality recyclates to the market, it is crucial to identify the barriers that plastic convertors experience when using plastic recyclates in high-quality products.

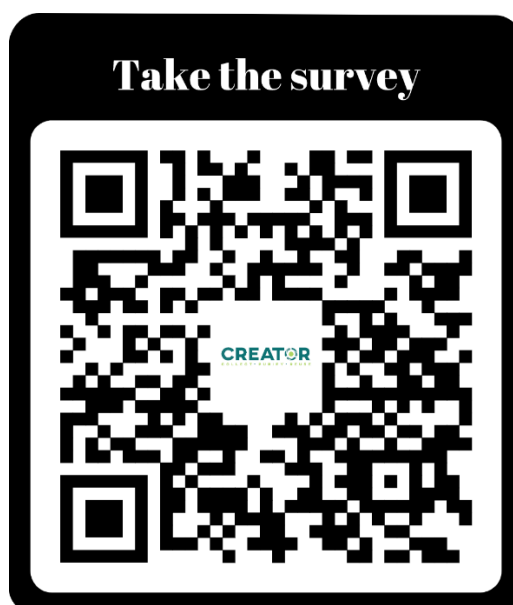
Plastic convertor? Fill in the survey!

To gauge the technical, legislative or societal barriers that plastic convertors encounter for large-scale deployment of plastic recyclates, CREATOR launches an online survey aimed at – both – convertors who already use recyclates in their products and those who do not (yet).

The results of the survey will be used to

- 1) further develop the **CREATOR process**
- 2) draft a **policy brief** addressed to the European Commission, suggesting policy measures to stimulate a circular economy for plastics.
